## Introduction

All Zebra printers used by Stuga have a web page interface. This is used to access all the printer settings

## Items

 [[Item:]] A fatal error occurred in the #info parser function

## Step 1 - Get IP address from configuration label

The IP address of the printer is needed to access the web page. This is done by creating a configuration label from the printer. The label is created in different ways depending on the printer

1. GK420d and earlier printers - Press and hold the button for two flashes, then let go
2. ZD620 - Press and hold the leftmost 2 buttons simultaneously until the label printing starts



## Step 2 - Type the IP Address into a browser

**!** If the IP address is not on the same subnet as the PC with the browser, you will not see the printer
