## Move Laser setup

Using the form below will rename a page, moving all of its history to the new name. The old title will become a redirect page to the new title. Be sure to check for [double](#) or [broken](#) redirects. You are responsible for making sure that links continue to point where they are supposed to go.

Note that the page will **not** be moved if there is already a page at the new title, unless it is a redirect and has no past edit history. This means that you can rename a page back to where it was renamed from if you make a mistake, and you cannot overwrite an existing page.

**Note:** This can be a drastic and unexpected change for a popular page; please be sure you understand the consequences of this before proceeding.
