Introduction

It is useful to be able to see a quick view of all cameras on a machine at once. A freeware program is available to do this IP Camera Viewer.exe

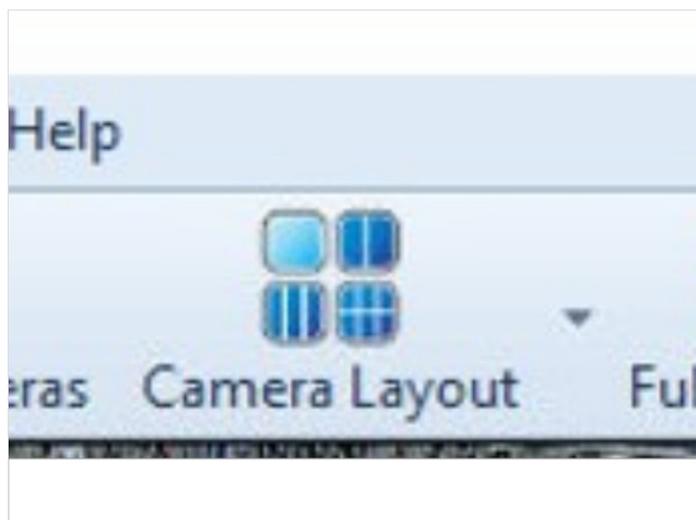
Ensure you have the IP address of the cameras to hand, and that the cameras are active and setup to Hikvision Camera Setup. The cameras should have a fixed IP address

Step 1 - Install IP Camera Viewer.exe

Upgrade if necessary

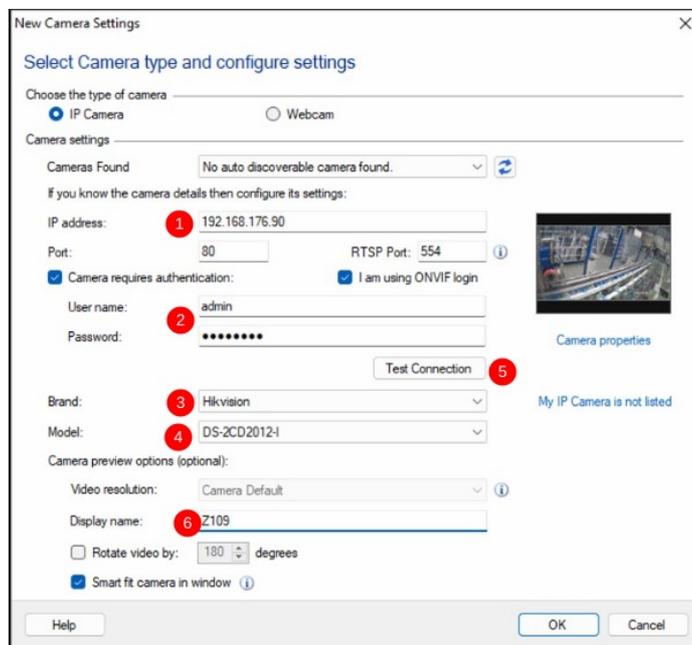
Step 2 - Choose camera layout

Choose the 4 screen layout



Step 3 - Add the cameras

1. IP Address
2. Username is admin / Password is the Stuga standard
3. Camera type is Hikvision
4. Model should be DS-2CD2012-I (may change as model is updated)
5. test the connection
6. Name the camera with the build number and the view you can see
