## Solution

Whilst a software fix is being written, one of these work arounds can remove a corrupted file that is stopping the machine from starting properly:

### Corrupt SAM files

A SAM file is created for each label that is printed. If they are not created properly, it causes the software to crash. To overcome this:

- 1. Open Windows Explorer (or My Computer)
- 2. Navigate to c:\DDRIVE\SAMOUT or c:\Multi\SAMOUT directory (either one or the other will exist)
- 3. Delete all the files in the director (the faulty file will be 0kB in size and be blank)

#### Corrupt work 449 file

The work.449 file is a record of which files the machine was last working on. If it is corrupted it can cause a crash

- 1. Open Windows Explorer (or My Computer)
- 2. Navigate to c:\DDRIVE\ or c:\Multi\ directory (either one or the other will exist)
- 3. Delete the file called work.449
