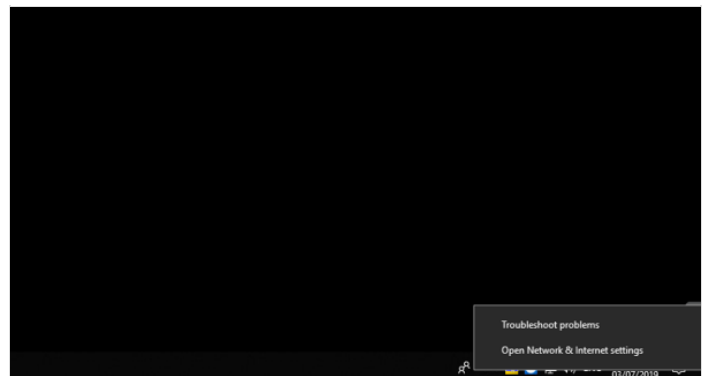
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## Step 1 -

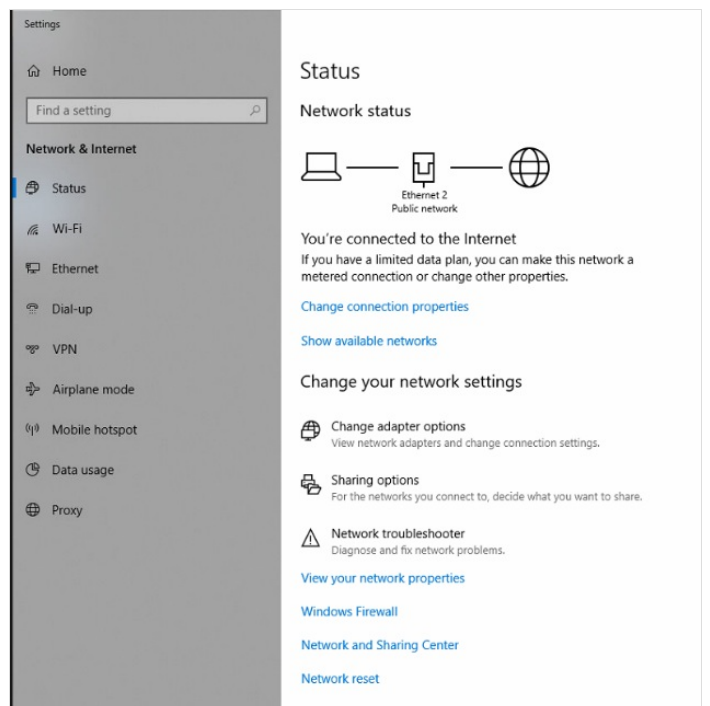
Go to Control Panel > Network and Sharing Centre.

 Alternatively you can access the Network and Sharing Centre by right clicking the network icon in the bottom right toolbar on the windows desktop.



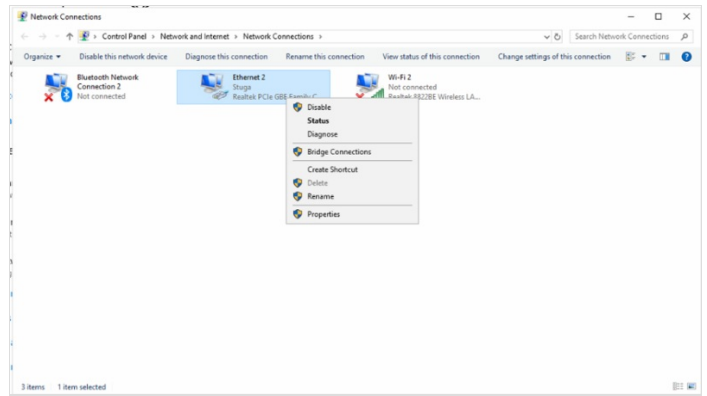
## Step 2 -

Now go to **Change Adaptor Settings**



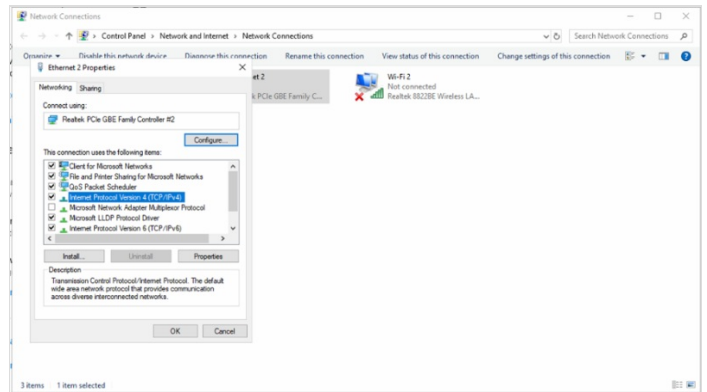
## Step 3 -

Go to the connected network and Right-Click > Properties



## Step 4 -

Scroll down to Internet Protocol Version 4(TCP/IPv4) and select. Now click Properties.

Input the desired IP Address, Subnet Mask, Default Gateway, Preferred and Alternate DNS Servers.
