Introduction

Requirements:

- The PC must have **Wi-Fi hardware** that supports Hosted Network (most do).
- You must have an active internet connection to share.

Step 1 - Open Settings

Press Win + I to open Settings.

Step 2 - Go to Network & Internet > Mobile hotspot

Step 3 - Choose the Internet connection to share

Under "Share my Internet connection from", choose Ethernet

Step 4 - Configure your hotspot

Click on Edit to set your Network name (SSID) and Password.

Step 5 - Turn it on

Toggle "Share my Internet connection with other devices" to On.

Step 6 - Connect your tablet

On your tablet, turn on Wi-Fi and connect to the new hotspot using the name and password you set.
