# TB0338 Saw 500mm Blade Upgrade Switch Block Relocation

The Sawing Module can be upgraded to use a 500mm blade. On machines with the older safety system, the larger 500mm blade cuts through the safety switch when doing 90 degree cuts.

## Solution

A block has been designed which relocates the safety switch out of the way of the blade, cutting at any angle.

# Required Parts

Part Number	Description	Quantity
F000004	M4 x 12 Socket Caphead Screws	2
F0000057	M4 Form A Washer	2
D0010924	Guard Switch Relocation Block	1

### Instructions

- 1. Remove bolt from handle which corresponds to where the relocation block is going to be mounted. Loosely refit the nut and bolt for the handle, now securing the relocation block.
- 2. Mark off where to drill 2 off clearance holes in the hood door which correspond to the 2 horizontally aligned holes on the block. (The 2 vertically aligned holes are to remount the guard switch key).
- 3. Fit 2 off M4 x 12 Socket Cap Screws and 2 off M4 washers to secure block to hood door. Now tighten bolt securing handle to hood door. Once fitted, drill/cut out new hole on Saw Top Hood to allow key to pass through.
- 4. Install guard switch key onto relocation block, and align guard switch to suit.
